- Built-in collision avoidance system
- Latest crash energy management

Closed operator's cab

- Increased visibility
- Eliminates likelihood of extraneous distractions

Wider door openings

- Maximized passenger capacity
- Maximized boarding efficiency

100% low-floor passenger area

- Eliminating all stairs for passenger entry
- Easier boarding and alighting

State-of-the-art enhanced communication systems

- Passenger information screens with dynamic destination signs for improved wayfinding and live service alerts
- Larger visual messaging screens for better visibility

Accessibility improvements

- Bridge plates at all double-leaf doors to assist with boarding and alighting
- Four priority areas for passengers using wheeled mobility devices
- No stairs for passenger entry

- Stop and service announcements provided in identical audio and visual formats
