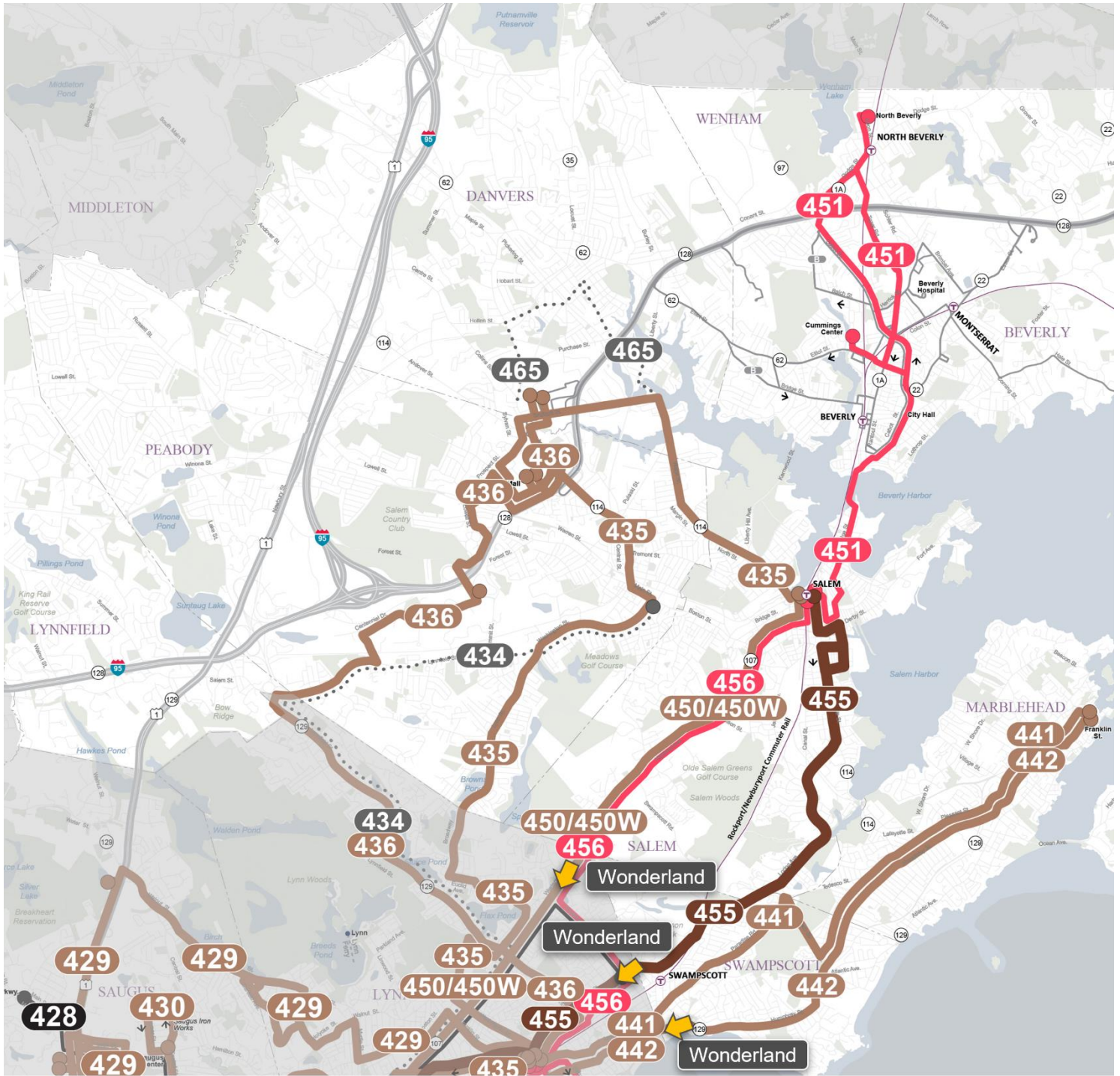

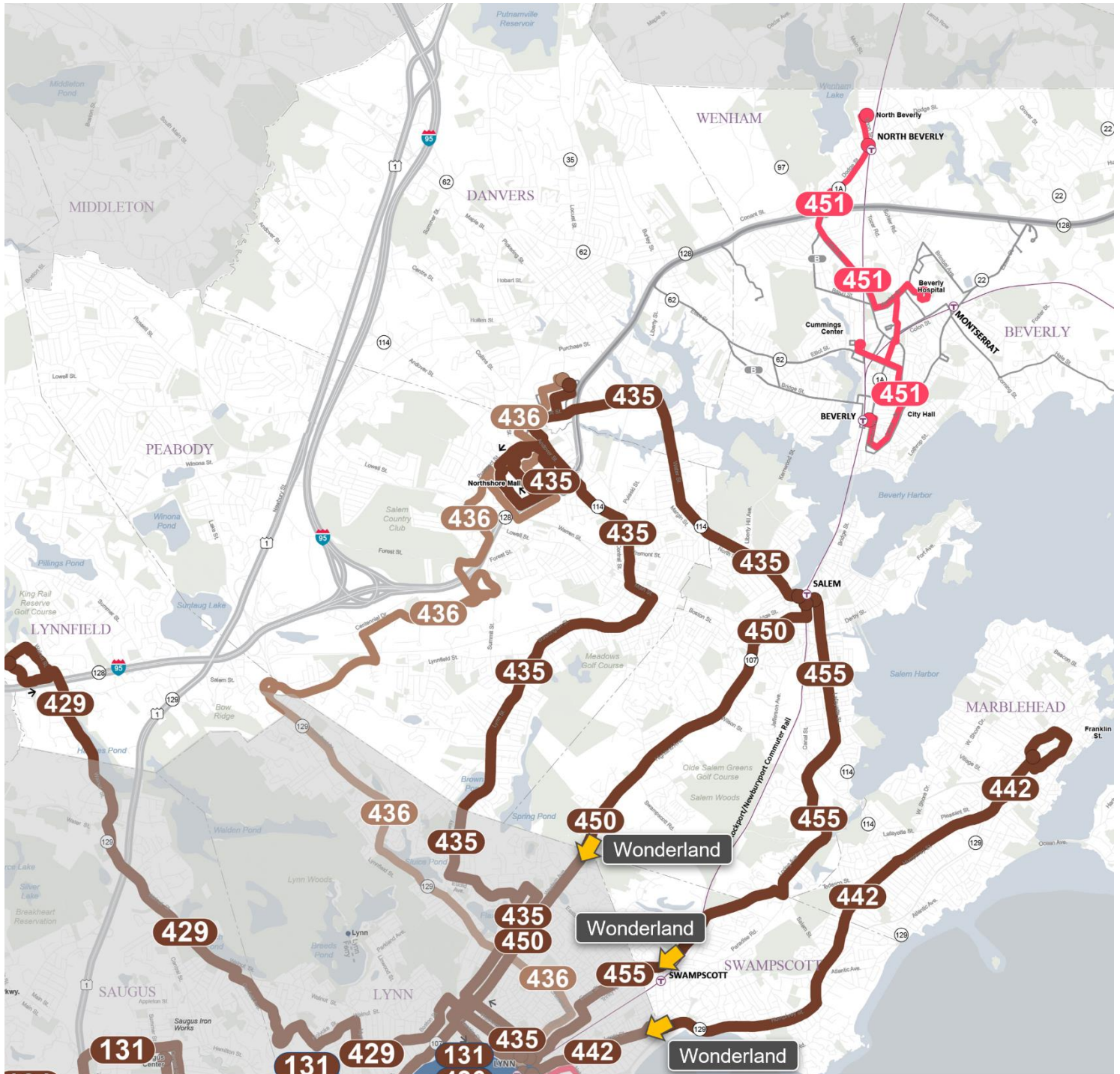

Service

- 000 **Every 15 min or better**
5:00 am to 1:00 am, 7 days a week. In some cases this service is provided by two overlapping routes.
- 000 **Every 30 min or better**
6:00 am to 10:00 pm, 7 days a week. Some routes run more frequently at peak. Some routes have service as early as 5:00 am and as late as 1:00 am.
- 000 **Every 60 min or better**
6:00 am to 7:00 pm 7 days a week. Some routes run more frequently at peak. Some routes run as late as 10:00 pm.
- 000 **Less Than Hourly**
- 000 **Peak-Only**
- 000 **Non-MBTA Route**
- 000 **Silver Line**

435 (Neptune Towers)	131, 426, 442, 455	Travel up to 1/3 mi to all-day high frequency corridors: Lynn Common (131/426) and Lynnway (442/455)
436 (Liberty Tree Mall - Central Square, Lynn)	436 -Liberty Tree Mall - Lynnfield - Lynn	Route 436 shortens to not serve Neptune Towers; new Sunday service
436 (Neptune Towers)	131, 426, 442, 455	Travel up to 1/3 mi to all-day high frequency corridors: Lynn Common (131/426) and Lynnway (442/455)
441 (Marblehead - Phillips Beach & New Ocean & Eastern Ave - Wonderland)	442 Marblehead - Swampscott - Wonderland	Route 442 frequency improves and replaces 441; shortens to not serve Old Town Marblehead
441 (Old Town Marblehead north of Mugford St)	442 Marblehead - Swampscott - Wonderland	Travel up to 1/3 mi Route 442
441 (Phillips Beach - Vinnin Sq - Paradise Rd)	442 Marblehead - Swampscott - Wonderland or 455 - Salem - Swampscott - Wonderland	Travel to Route 442, 455, or Swampscott Commuter Rail. Some stops over 1/2 mi
441 (Central Sq, Lynn - Wonderland)	442 Marblehead - Swampscott - Wonderland or 455 - Salem - Swampscott - Wonderland	Route 442 and 455 combine to provide all-day high frequency service via Lynnway

450 (Salem - Wonderland)	450 Salem - Lynn - Wonderland	All service to Wonderland; frequency improves on all days and replaces part of 455; shortens to not serve Revere-Haymarket segment
450 (McClellan Highway)	T104, 119 or 120	Travel up to 1/2 mi to Route T104, 119 or 120
450 (Boston)	Blue Line, Commuter Rail connections	Use Blue Line to 450, or Commuter Rail
451 (Beverly)	451 Beverly	Extend to Beverly Depot and Beverly Hospital; no longer serves Salem Depot
451 (Salem)	Salem Commuter Rail Station & bus connections	
455 (Salem - Lynn, Wonderland)	455 Salem - Swampscott - Wonderland	Route 455 shortens to not serve Shetland Park, extends via Lynnway to Wonderland instead of via Salem Turnpike; Sunday frequency improves
455 (Lynn - Wonderland via Western Ave)	450 Salem - Lynn - Wonderland	Route 450 frequency improves on all days and replaces part of 455, 456
456 (Salem - Western Ave)	450 Salem - Lynn - Wonderland	Route 450 frequency improves on all days and replaces part of 455, 456
465	435 Salem Depot - Peabody - Lynn	Route 435 current extension to Salem to replace 465 continues
